At our meeting on 16<sup>th</sup> June 2014 the parish council objected to the following application:-

RB2014/0727 Application to install two wind turbines at Parkcliffe Farm Wickersley *on the grounds that:* -

- *as well as being Green Belt, the land is designated as "High Landscape Value"*
- *approval would set a precedent which may lead to multiple applications from nearby land-owners*
- *the development does not fall within the current Unitary Development Plan*
- *the planning application documentation "Photomontage" appears to be somewhat biased/partisan. There are no photo points in the heart of Wickersley (point 15 is on the remote side of Wickersley and point 16 is low down Bawtry Road towards the Brecks).*
